- A large proportion of the materials used in our playground and equipment is sourced from local suppliers who have strong environmental values and credentials – minimising environmental impacts while conserving energy and natural resources.

The *materials* we use

Wherever possible, we choose sustainable materials that have limited negative impact on people and planet.

In action:

- We are passionate about the materials we use in our products, with an ever-increasing range featuring sustainably sourced, recycled and recyclable materials including FSC and PEFC accredited timber, aluminium, steel and wood plastic composite (WPC).
- A huge range of our products – from adventure towers and climbing structures to carousels – are constructed using New Zealand made steel and aluminium, which is 100 % recyclable.
- We use timber, including high quality, durable hardwood timber, sourced from renewable and responsibly-managed timber plantations. FSC and PEFC certified timber options available.
- We offer the option to include decking, poles and posts made from 100 % recycled and recyclable WPC supplied by our fellow New Zealand innovators, Future Post and Futurewood Decks.
- We mould our slides and tunnels from super tough High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) plastic that is UV, weather and impact resistant to guarantee longevity.
- With the increased focus on hygiene and infection control, we are proud to offer a select range of play equipment that can be made with non-toxic, FDA-approved anti-bacterial polymers.

We strive to conserve energy, manage water use and minimise waste to reduce the environmental impact of our operations.

In action:

- Our manufacturing facility in Wanganui, New Zealand is ISO 9001 Certified, demonstrating our commitment to continuously improving our management systems and processes.
- We use eco-friendly timber and cardboard packaging wherever possible; and take care to ensure effective waste management and separation of paper, cardboard and other recyclables.
- Our products are designed to have a long lifespan because quality, durability and sustainability go hand in hand. We also focus on smart disassembly in product design – so at the end of their useful life, products can be easily taken apart, recycled or disposed of responsibly.
- The majority of our products are manufactured locally providing employment opportunities and reducing the carbon emissions associated with shipping and transport. When we do source products from other play equipment manufacturers, we choose global leaders with proven environmental credentials.
