Who needs what?

Decide who you need to consult up-front and how you'll keep them informed. Planning a school playground means considering the needs and hopes of:

- students (current and future)
- parents
- teachers
- the school board
- maintenance staff
- relevant committees.

Do you need to call in the experts?

Decide if you need advice and practical help from a professional, like a landscape architect or Playground Centre design consultant. It can save time, money and frustration down the track – especially for complex projects.

What are your objectives?

Make the purpose of your playground crystal clear so you create a brilliant play experience for everyone.

- Who do you want to play there: ages, abilities?
- How many people will use it at once?
- Will adults be watching/observing play (so do you need bench seating and other amenities around)?
- What experience and opportunities do you want to provide: active play, social interaction, imaginative play, sensory play, challenges, adventures? Knowing this will help ensure you install the right equipment.









What are the site considerations?

Get to know your site well, so you get the most from it.

- What are the exact dimensions of the space available?
- What are the drainage and soil conditions?
- How exposed is it to the elements (wind, heat, snow)?
- What can you use to your advantage, such as existing trees for shade?
- Are there any particular challenges or constrictions (eg slopes)?



Budget, design & equipment

Your next step is to determine your budget, design your playground and choose your equipment.

- Do you want the design process to be consultative involving ideas and feedback from users and other stakeholders?
- Who will you choose to supply your equipment? Quality, durability and safety should be paramount along with fantastic service and trusted, expert advice.
- What 'look' do you want: modern, edgy, colourful, warm, natural?
- What equipment and design elements will meet your objectives? They need to appeal to your students while providing the right experiences and developmental opportunities.
- How can you make your playground accessible, so that children of all abilities can play together (eg specific equipment, colours, textures, safety surfacing)?
- If budget is tight, can you choose equipment that allows you to expand as more funding becomes available (eg Playground Centre's portable play systems)?
- What safety standards and requirements must be met?
- How much additional shading is needed (eg shelters or shade sails)?
- Appropriate surfacing is mandatory: what are you considering (eg sand, wood mulch, rubber padding)?

It might be volunteers (supervised by a professional), an installation team provided by your equipment supplier, or a local contractor. Just ensure you have the right mix of expertise, experience and labour to get it right.
