


Take learning outside and **reap** the **benefits**


Let's face it, just being outside has amazing benefits for everyone! Fresh air and a touch of sunshine can improve concentration, boost immunity and give a general feeling of wellbeing.

But, the latest research into outdoor classrooms reveals outdoor learning has a swathe of physical, cognitive and psychological benefits for children. In fact, children who are engaged in regular outdoor learning activities are showing improved results across the board!

Developmental benefits

- Fitness and physical skills including speed, reflexes, and reaction time.
- Gross and fine motor skills plus hand-eye coordination.
- Better balance, agility, strength and stamina through climbing.
- Improved confidence and judgement through taking measured risks.
- Strengthened core muscles and improved upper body control.
- Sensory stimulation from electronic games (lights, sounds, and sequences).
- Sensory development from musical instruments (creating and exploring sounds, building neural pathways) and sand and water play (textures, measurements).
- Problem solving and decision making (scaling the net or rocks and planning a path).
- Social or solo benefits: climbing can be a shared adventure or solo challenge + playing with sand encourages side-by-side enjoyment.
- Imaginative and creative play.
- Seating and tables for group learning and social interaction.
- Spaces and places for children who need calm/ quiet time.





Our outdoor classroom for smaller, more compact areas is an inviting, versatile space that is perfectly suited for both structured and unstructured learning activities.

Specifically designed for children aged 5-12years, the layout includes a range of low-profile seating and tables, covered area and garden, and is arranged to allow students to learn together as a group or take part in individual or small group activities.

Children can stretch out on the platforms and sketch and draw, sit comfortably and listen to a book being read, experiment with sound and rhythm on the chimes and bongo drums, or engage in e-learning games on the interactive e-wall.




Space to learn! This outdoor classroom is a launchpad for teachers and students to engage with each other and learning in fresh and exciting ways.



Large outdoor classroom




The sky's the limit! This outdoor classroom gives students the space to spread their wings and reach their full potential, in a supportive, encouraging and innovative teaching environment.

Inspired by the latest research, it's a fresh take on the outdoor classroom. Designed to enable educators to explore new teaching strategies, the concept features different zones that can be used to complement different areas of the curriculum—from science to art, music and PE. The large seating platforms can be used to complete written tasks, gather to listen to instructions or spread out to read, draw and paint.

Then, when it's action stations, children can break out into the zoned areas – to learn about confidence and strength on the free climbing rocks and net climbing structure; strengthen team work, sensory, fine and gross motor skills with sand play; challenge themselves and each other on the Speed Game (counting the seconds or timing each other); and explore sounds and rhythm on the musical instruments.


