Who provides grants?

Government

New Zealand Government departments establish grants programs to support policy areas and fund community infrastructure and facilities.

This can include specific playground funding initiatives.

Community Funds

There are not-for-profit organisations and private trusts which have **annual grants programs**, and the majority of these focus on supporting communities and children.

Councils

The majority of Councils have grants programs which include categories for **projects that benefit local residents** and promote community participation, inclusion and cohesion.

Corporations

Many national, regional, and even local businesses provide grants for projects which deliver positive health and wellbeing outcomes for children, families and communities such as playgrounds.
